



## NOTICE

### THE MARKET (SANGRE GRANDE) BYE LAWS, 1996

Please be informed that upon opening of the new Sangre Grande Market, only authorized vendors will be allowed to function in the market. The Corporation is in the process of regulating the use of the market, which will include implementation of the Market (Sangre Grande) Bye Laws. Therefore, all persons who wish to become vendors will be required to apply for a licence and pay the fees stated below. This licence must be renewed annually.

#### 1. Requirements for Licences:

Each person wishing to sell marketable commodities, must apply, in writing, to the Chief Executive Officer of the Sangre Grande Regional Corporation, for a licence to sell those commodities:

The applicant must:

- (1) Be 18 years or older
- (2) Produce a Police certificate of Character and one photocopy
- (3) Produce a food badge issued by the County Medical Officer of Health and one photocopy
- (4) 2 passport size photographs

#### 2. Fees for Licences will be as follows:

Licence to sell fresh meat and fish	\$25.00 per annum
Licence to sell other marketable commodities	\$20.00 per annum

3. The food badge issued by the County Medical Officer of Health must be displayed on the person of each licensed vendor.
4. The licence must be available for inspection by authorized officers of the Sangre Grande Regional Corporation
5. The grant of a licence does not guarantee a stall for vending.
6. Application forms are available from the offices of the Corporation on Brierley Street.
